Dear Sir or Madam:

Enclosed is the County of DuPage's completed Notice of Intent for Renewal of General Permit for Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s). Many of the Best Management Practices noted are applicable to the entirety of DuPage County. Thirty one municipalities and nine township roadway districts have chosen to participate as cooperating permit holders in Countywide local qualifying programs to meet the six control measures. These programs include:

- Employing a Stormwater Outreach Coordinator and contracting with the not-for-profit organizations SCARCE and The Conservation Foundation to provide education and outreach pertaining to the reduction of pollutants in stormwater runoff;
- Engaging a broad range of individuals and interests to provide input regarding policies and projects related to the control and reduction of pollutants in stormwater runoff. Such input is provided through hosting and participating in stakeholder meetings, as well as facilitating the involvement of the public in various activities;
- Participating in intergovernmental agreements with the majority of DuPage County municipalities regarding the screening for and tracing of illicit discharges into waters of the State from municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) outfalls. Stormwater Management staff hosts an illicit discharge hotline, performs field inspections of known outfall locations, and, where applicable, traces a suspected illicit discharge to the source;
- Reviewing construction permit submittals and offering post-construction inspections for a number of municipalities when special management areas are involved in the project (e.g., those containing wetland buffer, riparian enhancement, or wetland mitigation);
- Developing watershed plans, or components thereof, to include updated and revised floodplain maps, basin-specific ordinances, recommended improvement projects and programs to alleviate present and anticipated flooding problems, and identification of wetlands and critical habitats; and


- Offering stream maintenance services to remove large timber debris accumulations from waterways when contacted by requesting municipalities.
